Tuscany during the later Middle Ages and the Renaissance is one of the most splendid periods of Western cultural history. It is one of the very few that can stand comparison with Classical Greece and Rome.

Join us at our **Ninth Summer Symposium** when we shall return to Florence in the fourteenth century, when

the Medici were rising to be one of the most powerful families in the world, and Petrarch was not only the greatest poet in Europe but also the scholar who revived the study of ancient Greek and classical Latin.

This was also the period that gave birth to the paintings of Giotto, Simone Martini, Fra Angelico, Botticelli, and Michelangelo, the sculptures of Donatello and Ghiberti, and the architecture of Brunelleschi and Michelozzo. It was an age of faith and an age of Realpolitik, of Savonarola and Machiavelli.
